2 Peter 1

Truth

1 Timothy 2:4 ...who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

2 Timothy 2:25 Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth,

2 Timothy 3:7 ...always learning but never able to come to a knowledge of the truth.

Hebrews 10:26 If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left,

Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ to further the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness

Knowledge

1. Gnosis – general knowledge
2. Epignosis – complete, full, experiential knowledge

1 Corinthians 13

12 For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know (gnosis) in part; then I shall know (epignosis) fully, even as I am fully known.

Knowledge

1. Gnosis – general knowledge

- to know things by learning about them
- knowledge we gain for ourselves (study)
- head knowledge

2. Epignosis – complete, full, experiential knowledge

- to know things because we have experienced them
- knowledge that is given to us (revelation)
- Knowledge that is confirmed because we have believed it and acted upon it
