#### Extent of the Conquest under Joshua







#### **Tribal Allotment**

Deut 1:4 - Sihon the king of the Amorites, who lived in Heshbon, and Og the king of Bashan, who lived in Ashtaroth and in Edrei.

Josh 9:10 - ... the two kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan, to Sihon the king of Heshbon, and to Og king of Bashan, who lived in Ashtaroth.



Josh 12:4 - and Og king of Bashan, one of the remnant of the Rephaim, who lived at Ashtaroth and at Edrei <sup>5</sup> and ruled over Mount Hermon and Salecah and all Bashan . . . Deut 3:11 (For only Og the king of Bashan was left of the remnant of the Rephaim. Behold, his bed was a bed of iron. Is it not in Rabbah of the Ammonites? Nine cubits was its length, and four cubits its breadth, according to the common cubit.)

#### Bashan

- Domain of Rephaim; <u>Canaanite hell</u> and "place of the serpent"
- Domain of Baal, co-regent of El
  - Satan figure (Baal-Zebul)
  - Lord of the dead (defeated Mot, rose from dead)
  - Lord of the Rephaim; giants and evil spirits who inhabit the Underworld
- Mount Bashan (= Hermon) and its associations)
  - Gen 6, sons of God (Watchers), nephilim (Rephaim)

#### Psalm 68

<sup>15</sup> O mountain of God, mountain of Bashan; O many-peaked mountain, mountain of Bashan!

<sup>16</sup> Why do you look with hatred, O manypeaked mountain, at the mount that God desired for his abode, yes, where the LORD will dwell forever?

#### Psalm 68

<sup>17</sup> The chariots of God are twice ten thousand, thousands upon thousands; the Lord is among them; Sinai is now in the sanctuary.

<sup>18</sup> You ascended on high, leading a host of captives in your train and receiving gifts among men, even among the rebellious, that the LORD God may dwell there.

# Summary

#### Victory over Bashan meant:

- Dominion over Hermon, Rephaim, evil spirits, nephilim (Gen 6)
- Dominion over death / the gates of hell
- Defeat of Baal-Zebul, lord of the dead,

Caesarea Philippi / Banias / Panias

- Mark 8:27-30 (Matt 16:13-16; Lk 9:18-20)
  - Peter's Confession ("And Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi")

#### "Gates of Hell"

- You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not be able to withstand it.
  - Catholics argue "rock" (petra) is Peter
  - Protestants argue "rock" is God/Christ (1 Cor 10:4)
  - Neither correct: The rock is where they are standing, at the foot of Hermon (Panias)

"against" not in original text (just verb + object);

**better:** "the gates of hell will not *withstand* it"

  - "And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain"

# Jesus & Cosmic Geography Transfiguration

- In early church tradition, the location of the mount of transfiguration was believed by many to be Mount Tabor.
- The earliest witness to this tradition is the 4<sup>th</sup> century A.D.
- The gospels themselves give no name, and so the tradition has no biblical precedent.

- Mount Hermon is considered by many the better choice since it is much higher than Tabor (8,500 feet vs. 1,843 feet), which would fit better with the description of a "high mountain" by Mark (and in Matthew 17:1).

#### The theme of cosmic reversal

#### **BIRTH OF JESUS**

The open, yet secret, arrival of the King

• **defeats death**, nullifying the claim of the lord of the dead on believers

• inaugurates the kingdom, initiating the reclaiming of the nations

•Begins at ground zero; gates of hell

 heals the transgression of heaven and earth whose effects still linger

#### Romans 10

<sup>14</sup> How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? . . .

<sup>18</sup> But I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have, for

# Psalm 19

The constellation Virgo is the only constellation that represents a woman. For 20 days Virgo was "clothed" with the sun, but the exact day when "the moon was under her feet" could only occur during an 80 minute period within that span of days.










#### 3 B.C.

#### September 11

The Sept. 11, 3 B.C. date also corresponded to Rosh-Hashanah (Tishri 1), New Year's day for Jews and the Day of Trumpets.

Tishri 1 was also the "New Year's Day" of the civil calendar according to the calendar accepted in Judah during the divided monarchy (Thiele). That is, it marked the first day of the reign of every new Davidic king.





### **Jewish Calendar**

The **first month** of the Jewish calendar = Nisan

Nisan falls in the **spring**, when **Passover** occurs.

This **first month** reckoning was set in Exod 12:1-2

This was an innovation; Passover had not existed prior to the exodus.

### **Jewish Calendar**

However, the ancient **beginning of the year is in Tishri**, the seventh month

**Tishri** brings in the fall season (harvest)

**Tishri 1** = Rosh Hashanah, when the year number changes.

### **Jewish Calendar**

This **concept of different starting points for an annual cycle** seems strange, but we use it as well.

- Our "new year" starts in January, but there are other "new year" beginnings in our culture.
- The new "school year" starts in September
- Businesses have "fiscal years" that start at various times of the year.

- Gen 7:6 "Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters came upon the earth."
- Gen 7:11 "In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, <u>in the second month</u>, on the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep burst forth, and the windows of the heavens were opened."
  - Noah was 600 years old when flood began in the month after Tishri ("second month")

#### (after dove didn't return)

Gen 8:13, 14 - In the six hundred and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month (Tishri 1), the waters were dried from off the earth. And Noah removed the covering of the ark and looked, and behold, the face of the ground was dry. In the second month, on the twentyseventh day of the month, the earth had dried out.

(first drying = Tishri 1 = a year since the flood began)

• Noah had therefore turned 601 sometime before the earth had dried out.

 Early Judaism took this to mean that Noah's birthday was Tishri 1

• Where have we seen Tishri 1 before?

• This would then mean Jesus and Noah shared a birthday (Tishri 1)

• This would create a mental and spiritual link in the Jewish mind between Jesus and Noah

# Flood Timing and Noah

• Astronomically, the second month is marked by the heliacal appearance of the Pleiades

 The Pleiades (Hebrew, kima; כימה) are mentioned three times in OT (Amos 5:8; Job 9:9; 38:31), always in pairing with Orion (kesil).

 Many in ancient world (<u>including Jews</u>) associated Orion with the giants.

## Flood Timing and Noah

 Job 38:31 - "Can you bind the chains of the Pleiades or loose the cords of Orion?"

• 11QTgJob - "Can you bind the chains of the *naphila* or loose the cords of Orion?"

- Noah's birthday associated with God's judgment (flood)
- Flood wiped earth clean of evil
- Source of that evil was transgression of heaven and earth (Watchers; Gen 6)
  - The offending sons of God put in the Abyss (Tartarus = 2 Peter 2:4) "until time of the end"
- Noah's birth associated with death of the nephilim
- But the evil persisted (Gen 6:4; Num 13:33)

# **Theological Messaging**

- Jesus' birth signaled the same thing
- Reversal of evil of sons of God and nephilim
- Jesus = king = kingdom
  - Kingdom inaugurated during his ministry
  - Death and resurrection = seated at right hand of God "at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him" (1 Pet 3:22)
- His return = time of end / release of Watchers (Rev 9)
