















What the Bible says...







Matthew 15:19

For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders.



What is the Heart?

Proverbs:

4:23 Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

6:14 Perversity *is* in his heart, He devises evil continually, He sows discord.

12:25 Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad.

14:30 A sound heart *is* life to the body, But envy *is* rottenness to the bones.



What is the Heart?

Proverbs:

5:13 A merry heart makes a cheerful countenance, But by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

16:9 A man's heart plans his way.

16:23 The heart of the wise teaches his mouth, And adds learning to his lips.

20:5 Counsel in the heart of man *is like* deep water

23:7 For as he thinks in his heart, so *is* he.

What is an Idol?

The idols mentioned in the 2nd Commandment are generally carved and crafted statues.

What are the idols of the Heart (Ezek 14:3)?

We could also call them “Ruling Desires”

Anything that you put as a priority above God.

If you are willing to sin to get something, then it is an idol of your Heart.



What is an Idol?

Words we might use today:

Control

Manipulation, Aggression, Intimidation, Domination

Peace/Comfort

Escapism, Avoidance, Fleeing, Unavailability

People Pleasing

Deception, Insincerity, Appeasement, Compliance

Entitlement

Demanding, Pouting, Forceful, Merit

Prosperity/

Possessions

Materialism, Stinginess, Discontentment

Recognition/Respect

Self-Righteous, Criticism, Compromise, Self-Pity

Root of all of these is PRIDE!

Benefits of a Godly Heart


God has numerous promises for those with a Godly Heart

The Gospel!


We need a new Heart!

How do we draw near to God?

Hebrews 4

¹² For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.


