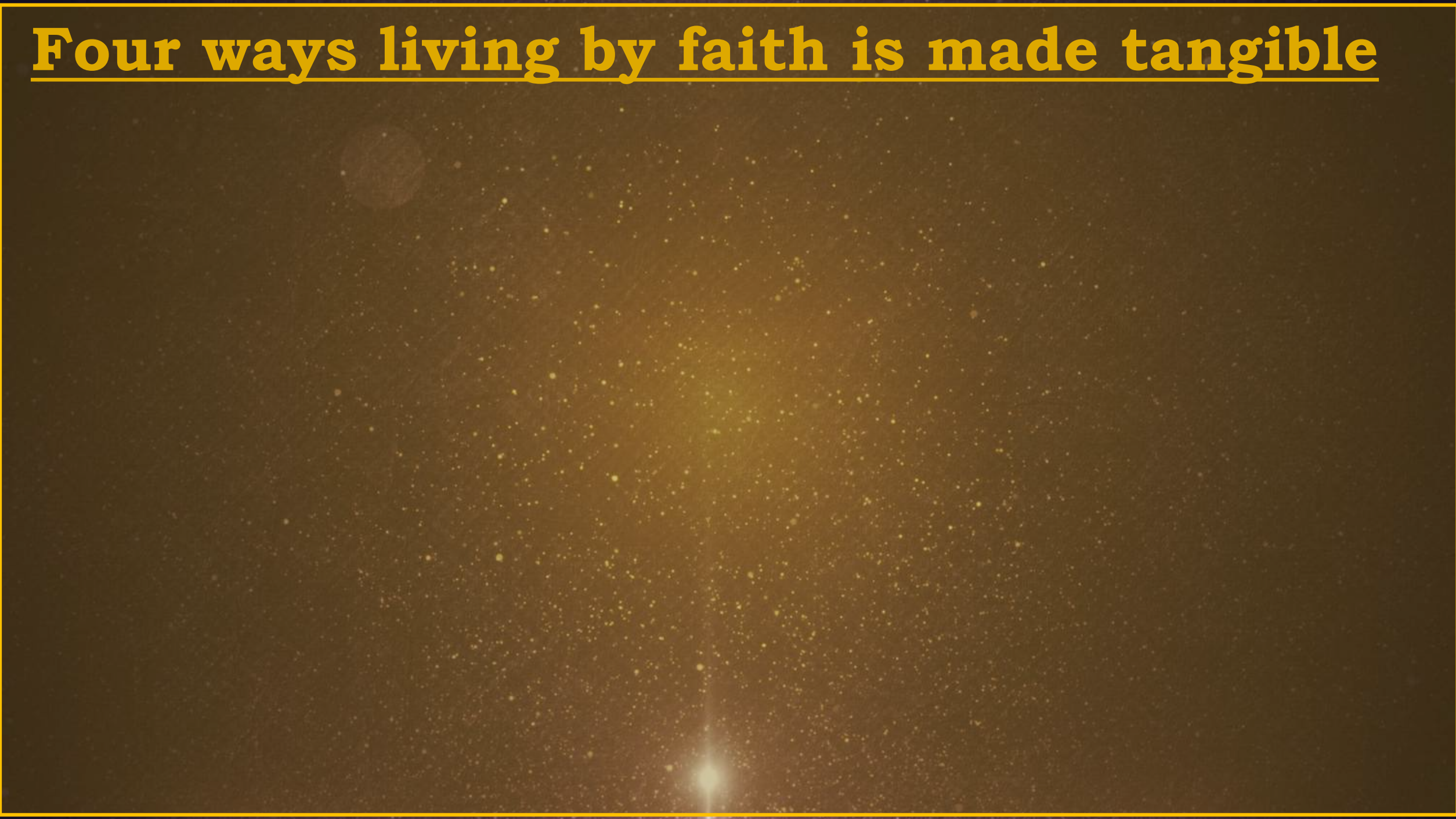

## Hebrews 6
