A Mental Being

Self-conscience – self awareness Able to reason – to think Creative – appreciate beauty Emotional

What does it mean that man is created in the image of God?

A Moral Being

God-consciousness

Adam was created innocent and holy

Possess a will – ability to choose or make decisions

Able to know good and evil (since the fall)

What does it mean that man is created in the image of God?

A Relational Being

Able to communicate
Able to love, care for, share with others relationally
Eternal being – a soul
Relational being that is compatible with God
