# HOM DO AON SEEVES

• <u>Lifestyle website YourTango.com</u> polled 100 mental health professionals and found that communication problems was cited as the most common factor that leads to divorce (65 percent), followed by couples' inability to resolve conflict (43 percent).

• They survey also found that men and women have different communication complaints. Seventy percent of the experts surveyed said that men cite nagging and complaining as the top communication problem in their marriage. # 4 RULES OF BIBLICAL COMMUNICATION

BASED ON EPHESIANS 4:25-32

<sup>25</sup> Therefore, Laying aside falsehood, speak truth each ONE OF YOU WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, FOR WE ARE MEMBERS OF ONE another. <sup>26</sup> Be angry, and *yet* do not sin; do not let the sun GO DOWN ON YOUR ANGER, <sup>27</sup> AND DO NOT GIVE THE DEVIL AN OPPORTUNITY. 28 HE WHO STEALS MUST STEAL NO LONGER; BUT RATHER HE MUST LABOR, PERFORMING WITH HIS OWN HANDS WHAT IS GOOD, SO THAT HE WILL HAVE SOMETHING TO SHARE WITH ONE WHO HAS NEED. <sup>29</sup> LET NO UNWHOLESOME WORD PROCEED FROM YOUR MOUTH, BUT ONLY SUCH A WORD AS IS GOOD FOR EDIFICATION ACCORDING TO THE NEED OF THE MOMENT, SO THAT IT WILL GIVE GRACE TO THOSE WHO HEAR.

# 4 RULES OF BIBLICAL COMMUNICATION 1. BE HONEST – WE MUST PUT OFF FALSEHOOD

- COMMON EXAMPLES OF DISHONESTY:
  - OUTRIGHT DECEIT
  - KEEPING A SECRET WHEN IT SHOULD BE DISCLOSED
  - EXAGGERATION AT INAPPROPRIATE TIMES
  - CONFLICT BETWEEN VERBAL AND NON-VERBAL COMMUNICATIONS
  - DISTORTING THE REAL MESSAGE: INNUENDO

# 1. BE HONEST – WE MUST SPEAK THE TRUTH

- BECAUSE PROBLEMS CANNOT BE SOLVED UNLESS THEY ARE EXPRESSED
- BECAUSE PEOPLE CANNOT READ MINDS
- WE MUST SPEAK TRUTH IN THE CONTEXT OF LOVE
  - EPH 4:15 BUT SPEAKING TRUTH IN LOVE, WE ARE TO GROW UP IN ALL ASPECTS INTO HIM WHO IS THE HEAD, EVEN CHRIST

# 2. KEEP CURRENT!

• EPHESIANS 4:26-27 BE ANGRY, AND YET DO NOT SIN; DO NOT LET THE SUN GO DOWN ON YOUR ANGER, <sup>27</sup> AND DO NOT GIVE THE DEVIL AN OPPORTUNITY.

# 4 RULES OF BIBLICAL COMMUNICATION 2. KEEP CURRENT!

- Use anger to solve today's problems today
- DO NOT MAKE EXCUSES FOR FAILING TO COMMUNICATE
  - COMMON COMMUNICATION CUTOFFS INCLUDE:
    - CRYING
    - THREATING AN EXPLOSION
    - Using a 'bottom line' statement ("all I have to say is ...)
    - LEAVING THE ROOM OR THE HOUSE

- DEAL WITH PROBLEMS QUICKLY
  - MATTHEW 6:34 SO DO NOT WORRY ABOUT TOMORROW, FOR TOMORROW WILL CARE FOR ITSELF, EACH DAY HAS ENOUGH TROUBLE OF ITS OWN.

- QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE BRINGING UP A PROBLEM.
  - DO I HAVE THE FACTS RIGHT?
    - Proverbs 18:13 He who gives an answer before he hears, It is folly and shame to him.
  - SHOULD LOVE HIDE IT? IS IT SINFUL? IS IT HINDERING GROWTH?
    - 1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

- QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE BRINGING UP A PROBLEM.
  - IS MY TIMING RIGHT?
    - Proverbs 15:23 A man has joy in an apt answer, and how delightful is a timely word!
  - IS MY ATTITUDE RIGHT? AM I TRYING TO HELP THE OTHER PERSON?
    - Philippians 2:3-4 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;  $^4$  do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

- QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE BRINGING UP A PROBLEM.
  - ARE MY WORDS LOVING?
    - EPHESIANS 4:15 BUT SPEAKING THE TRUTH IN LOVE ...
  - HAVE | PRAYED FOR GOD'S HELP?
    - PROVERBS 3:5 TRUST IN THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND DO NOT LEAN ON YOUR OWN UNDERSTANDING.

# 3. ATTACK THE PROBLEM (NOT THE PERSON)!

• EPHESIANS 4:29-30 LET NO UNWHOLESOME WORD PROCEED FROM YOUR MOUTH, BUT ONLY SUCH A WORD AS IS GOOD FOR EDIFICATION ACCORDING TO THE NEED OF THE MOMENT, SO THAT IT WILL GIVE GRACE TO THOSE WHO HEAR. 30 DO NOT GRIEVE THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD, BY WHOM YOU WERE SEALED FOR THE DAY OF REDEMPTION.

- AVOID "UNWHOLESOME WORDS"
  - WORDS THAT ATTACK THE PERSON'S CHARACTER
    - MATTHEW 5:21-22 "YOU HAVE HEARD THAT THE ANCIENTS WERE TOLD,
       'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT MURDER" AND "WHOEVER COMMITS MURDER
       SHALL BE LIABLE TO THE COURT. '22 BUT I SAY TO YOU THAT EVERYONE
       WHO IS ANGRY WITH HIS BROTHER SHALL BE GUILTY BEFORE THE COURT;
       AND WHOEVER SAYS TO HIS BROTHER, "YOU GOOD-FOR-NOTHING,"
       SHALL BE GUILTY BEFORE THE SUPREME COURT; AND WHOEVER SAYS, "YOU
       FOOL," SHALL BE GUILTY ENOUGH TO GO INTO THE FIERY HELL.

- AVOID "UNWHOLESOME WORDS"
  - Words that tear down, rip apart or hinder growth
    - James 3:5-6 SO also the tongue is a small part of the body, and yet it boasts of great things. See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire! <sup>6</sup> And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.

- AVOID "UNWHOLESOME WORDS"
  - Words that confuse the discussion or by-pass the conflict
  - Words that grieve the Holy Spirit
    - EPHESIANS 4:30 DO NOT GRIEVE THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD, BY WHOM YOU WERE SEALED FOR THE DAY OF REDEMPTION.

- Use "edifying" words that encourage others and build them up.
- WHEN THIS RULE IS OBEYED WITH RESPECT TO PROBLEM
   SOLVING, WORDS WILL BE SOLUTION ORIENTED AND
   ACCOMPANIED WITH THE RIGHT TONE AND BODY LANGUAGE

# 4 RULES OF BIBLICAL COMMUNICATION 4. ACT! (DON'T REACT)

- WE MUST GUARD AGAINST SINFUL REACTIONS IN OUR HEARTS
   AND OUR ACTIONS
  - BITTERNESS: A STATE OF RESENTMENT: A DESIRE TO THINK ABOUT AND TREAT SOMEONE ACCORDING TO EVIL
  - WRATH: INTENSE ANGER NORMALLY RESULTING IN PASSIONATE OUTBURSTS
  - Anger: Settled indignation or hostility that frequently seeks revenge
  - CLAMOR: LOUD SCREAMING AND SHOUTING NORMALLY ASSOCIATED WITH QUARRELS AND BRAWLS
  - MALICE: WICKEDNESS IN THE SENSE OF A DESIRE TO HARM THE OTHER PERSON

# 4. ACT! (DON'T REACT)

- WE MUST GUARD AGAINST OUR NATURAL TENDENCY TO BE DEFENSIVE ABOUT DEALING WITH OUR OWN SINS
  - GENESIS 3:7-13 THE SERPENT DECEIVED ME, AND I ATE
- SINFUL ARGUMENTS ARE POSSIBLE ONLY IF EACH PERSON REACTS

# 4. ACT! (DON'T REACT)

- WE MUST SEEK TO APPLY GODLY ACTIONS AND ATTITUDES.
  - KIND: BENEVOLENT, HELPFUL, COURTEOUS
  - TENDERHEARTED: COMPASSIONATE, SYMPATHETIC, AFFECTIONATE
  - FORGIVING: A WILLINGNESS TO PARDON THE REPENTANT GUILTY PERSON FROM MORAL LIABILITY AND WORK TOWARD RECONCILIATION
