Romans 15:4 For everything that was written in the past was written for our instruction, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures, we might have hope.

42 When the words of her older son Esau were relayed to Rebekah, she sent for her younger son Jacob and told him, "Look, your brother Esau is consoling himself by plotting to kill you. 43 So now, my son, obey my voice and flee at once to my brother Laban in Haran.

44 Stay with him for a while, until your brother's fury subsides— 45 until your brother's rage against you wanes and he forgets what you have done to him. Then I will send for you and bring you back from there. Why should I lose both of you in one day?" 46 Then Rebekah said to Isaac, "I am weary of my life because of these Hittite women. If Jacob takes a Hittite wife from among them, what good is my life?"

1 So Isaac called for Jacob and blessed him. "Do not take a wife from the Canaanite women," he commanded.

2"Go at once to Paddan-aram, to the house of your mother's father Bethuel, and take a wife from among the daughters of Laban, your mother's brother.

- 3 May God Almighty bless you and make you fruitful and multiply you, so that you may become a company of peoples.

8 But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be under a curse!

9 As we have said before, so now I say again:

If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you embraced, let him be under a curse!

2 Corinthians 4

1 Therefore, since we have this ministry through the mercy of God, we do not lose heart.

- 2 Instead, we have renounced secret and shameful ways.
- We do not practice deceit, nor do we distort the word of God.
- On the contrary, by open proclamation of the truth, we commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
- 3 And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing.

2 Corinthians 4:4 The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers so they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. 5 For we do not proclaim ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. 6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

If sinners be damned, at least let them leap to hell over our dead bodies.

And if they perish, let them perish with our arms wrapped about their knees, imploring them to stay. If hell must be filled, let it be filled in the teeth of our exertions, and let not one go unwarned and unprayed for.
