Galatians 5

Galatians 6

- 2. We are to be humble and approachable to others**

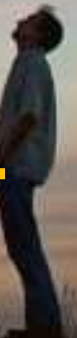

Restoring Someone Caught in a Sin

A person who cares enough to restore a brother may be tempted:

- to look down on the brother and think pridefully of himself
- to be more concerned with what others think than truly loving his brother
- to be concerned with his own glory rather than God's
- much more than if he just "minded his own business"
- to respond sinfully if he receives a poor response
- to be prideful of himself if his mission is successful
- and become entangled in the sins of others
- and become entangled in the deceit of others

2 Corinthians 13

5 Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves.

Can't you see for yourselves that Jesus Christ is in you—unless you actually fail the test?




James 1

22 Be doers of the word, and not hearers only. Otherwise, you are deceiving yourselves.

23 For anyone who hears the word but does not carry it out is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror,

24 and after observing himself goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.

25 But the one who looks intently into the perfect law of freedom, and continues to do so—not being a forgetful hearer, but an effective doer—he will be blessed in what he does.

Jude

20 But you, beloved, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit,

21 keep yourselves in the love of God as you await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you eternal life.

22 And indeed, have mercy on those who doubt;

23 save others by snatching them from the fire; and to still others, show mercy tempered with fear, hating even the clothing stained by the flesh.

Responsibilities of those who WBTS

13. We are to persevere in faith and good deeds knowing that there WILL BE a harvest



Galatians 6

10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to the family of faith.

14. We are to look for opportunities to do good to all

- especially those in the faith
