If what you heard from the beginning **abides** in you, then you too will **abide** in the Son and in the Father.

25 And this is the promise that He Himself made to us: eternal life.





...whether it is well received or not.

Justin Martyr (100 –165AD) “First Apology” 155AD

“On the day called Sunday there is a gathering together in the same place of all who live in a given city or rural district.

The memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read, as long as time permits.

Then when the reader ceases, the president in a discourse admonishes and urges the imitation of these good things.

Next we all rise together and send up prayers.”

The Apostles' Teaching

2 Timothy 4
