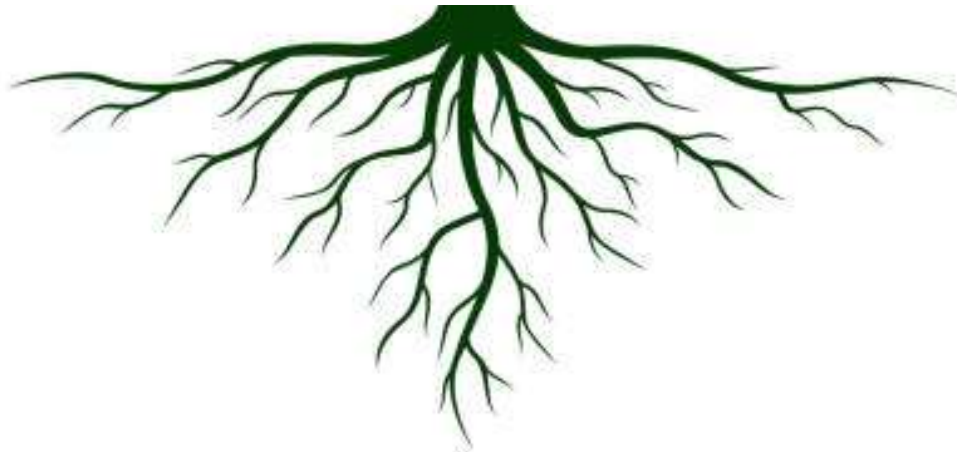

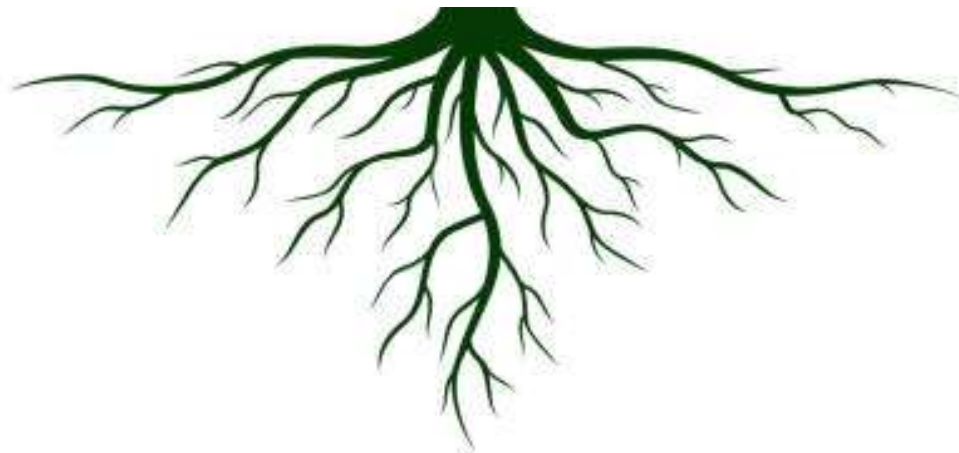

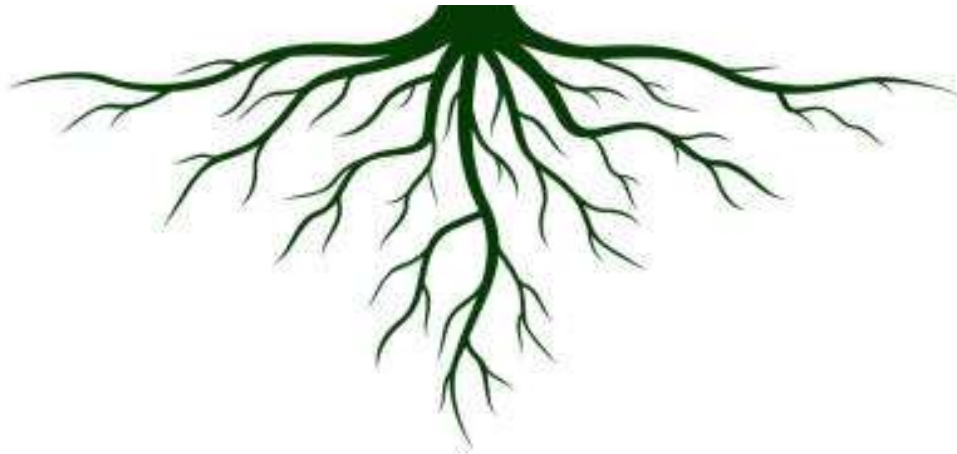

# A Focus on *FEAR*
