Hebrews 7 11 Now if perfection could have been attained through the Levitical priesthood (for on this basis the people received the law), why was there still need for another priest to appear—one in the order of Melchizedek and not in the order of Aaron? 12 For when the priesthood is changed, the law must be changed as well. 18 So the former commandment is set aside because it was weak and useless 19 (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God.





Moral Law - fulfilled yet binding & enhanced Ceremonial Law Civil Law Leviticus 18 24 Do not defile yourselves by any of these practices, for by all these things the nations I am driving out before you have defiled themselves. 25 Even the land has become defiled, so I am punishing it for its sin, and the land will vomit out its inhabitants. 26 But you are to keep My statutes and ordinances, and you must not commit any of these abominations—neither your native-born nor the foreigner who lives among you.

Leviticus 18 27 For the men who were in the land before you committed all these abominations, and the land has become defiled. 28 So if you defile the land, it will vomit you out as it spewed out the nations before you. 29 Therefore anyone who commits any of these abominations must be cut off from among his people. 30 You must keep My charge not to practice any of the abominable customs that were practiced before you, so that you do not defile yourselves by them.

Exodus 21

- 12 Whoever strikes and kills a man must surely be put to death.
- 13 If, however, he did not lie in wait, but God allowed it to happen,
- then I will appoint for you a place where he may flee.

 14 But if a man schemes and acts willfully against his neighbor to kill him, you must take him away from My altar to be put to death.
- 16 Whoever kidnaps another man must be put to death, whether he sells him or the man is found in his possession.
- 17 Anyone who curses his father or mother must surely be put to death.

Exodus 21

- 28 If an ox gores a man or woman to death, the ox must surely be stoned, and its meat must not be eaten. But the owner of the ox shall not be held responsible.
- 29 But if the ox has a habit of goring, and its owner has been warned yet does not restrain it, and it kills a man or woman, then the ox must be stoned and its owner must also be put to death.
- 30 If payment is demanded of him instead, he may redeem his life by paying the full amount demanded of him.

Exodus 22 2 If a thief is caught breaking in and is beaten to death, no one shall be guilty of bloodshed. 3 But if it happens after sunrise, there is guilt for his bloodshed.

NIV – 3 but if it happens after sunrise, the defender is guilty of bloodshed.

NLT – 3 But if it happens in daylight, the one who killed the thief is guilty of murder.

Exodus 22

- ESV 2 If a thief is found breaking in and is struck so that he dies, there shall be no bloodguilt for him,
- 3 but if the sun has risen on him, there shall be bloodguilt for him.
- He shall surely pay. If he has nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft.
- 4 If the stolen beast is found alive in his possession, whether it is an ox or a donkey or a sheep, he shall pay double.

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
