Martin Lloyd-Jones (Sermon on the Mount)

- 1 Meek people do not boast in themselves.

 - and will not always need to defend themselves when people point out their flaws and weaknesses.
- 3. Meek people have a teachable spirit.
 - They are not gullible, but they are open to criticism and expect it because they know they have a lot to learn.
- 4. Meek people love the word of God and submit to it.
 - They do not chafe against it.
- 5. Meek people tend to be satisfied
 - because they do not always believe they are entitled to more.
- 6. Meek people are not weak people.
 - A meek person will stand immovable in God's truth because they submit to God before they will submit to man.
