Deuteronomy 18 – Accuracy (applicable for predictive prophecy)

- 9"When you come into the land that the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominable practices of those nations.
- 10 There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering,
- anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer 11 or a charmer or a medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead,

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- 12 for whoever does these things is an abomination to the LORD.
- And because of these abominations the LORD your God is driving them out before you.

13 You shall be blameless before the LORD your God, 14 for these nations, which you are about to dispossess, listen to fortune-tellers and to diviners.

But as for you, the LORD your God has not allowed you to do this.

Three veils that God has put in place:

- 1. The spirit realm
- 2. The future
- 3. The grave

- They will not belong to the council of My people or be recorded in the register of the house of Israel, nor will they enter the land of Israel.
- Then you will know that I am the Lord GOD.

- "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you.
- They are filling you with false hopes.
- They speak visions from their own minds,
- not from the mouth of the LORD.
- 17 They keep saying to those who despise Me,

- and to everyone who walks in the stubbornness of his own heart,
- 'No harm will come to you.'
- 21 I did not send these prophets,
- yet they have run with their message;
- I did not speak to them, yet they have prophesied.

- "Do I not fill the heavens and the earth?" declares the LORD. 25"I have heard the sayings of the prophets who prophesy lies in My name: 'I had a dream! I had a dream!'

26 How long will this continue in the hearts of these prophets who prophesy falsehood, and who prophesy the deceit of their own heart? 28 Let the prophet who has a dream retell it, but let him who has My word speak it truthfully. For what is straw compared to grain?" declares the LORD. 29"Is not My word like fire," declares the LORD, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?" 30"Therefore behold," declares the LORD, "I am against the prophets who steal from one another words they attribute to Me."

31"Yes," declares the LORD, "I am against the prophets who wag their own tongues and proclaim, 'The LORD declares it.' "
32"Indeed," declares the LORD, "I am against those who prophesy false dreams and retell them to lead My people astray with their reckless lies.

It was not I who sent them or commanded them, and they are of no benefit at all to these people," declares the LORD. It is a very serious thing for anyone to claim that they are speaking words that come from God.
 The one source we know is from God is the written word.

12 For the word of God is living and active.
Sharper than any double-edged sword, it pierces even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow.
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 - We have something better the living word to guide us.
